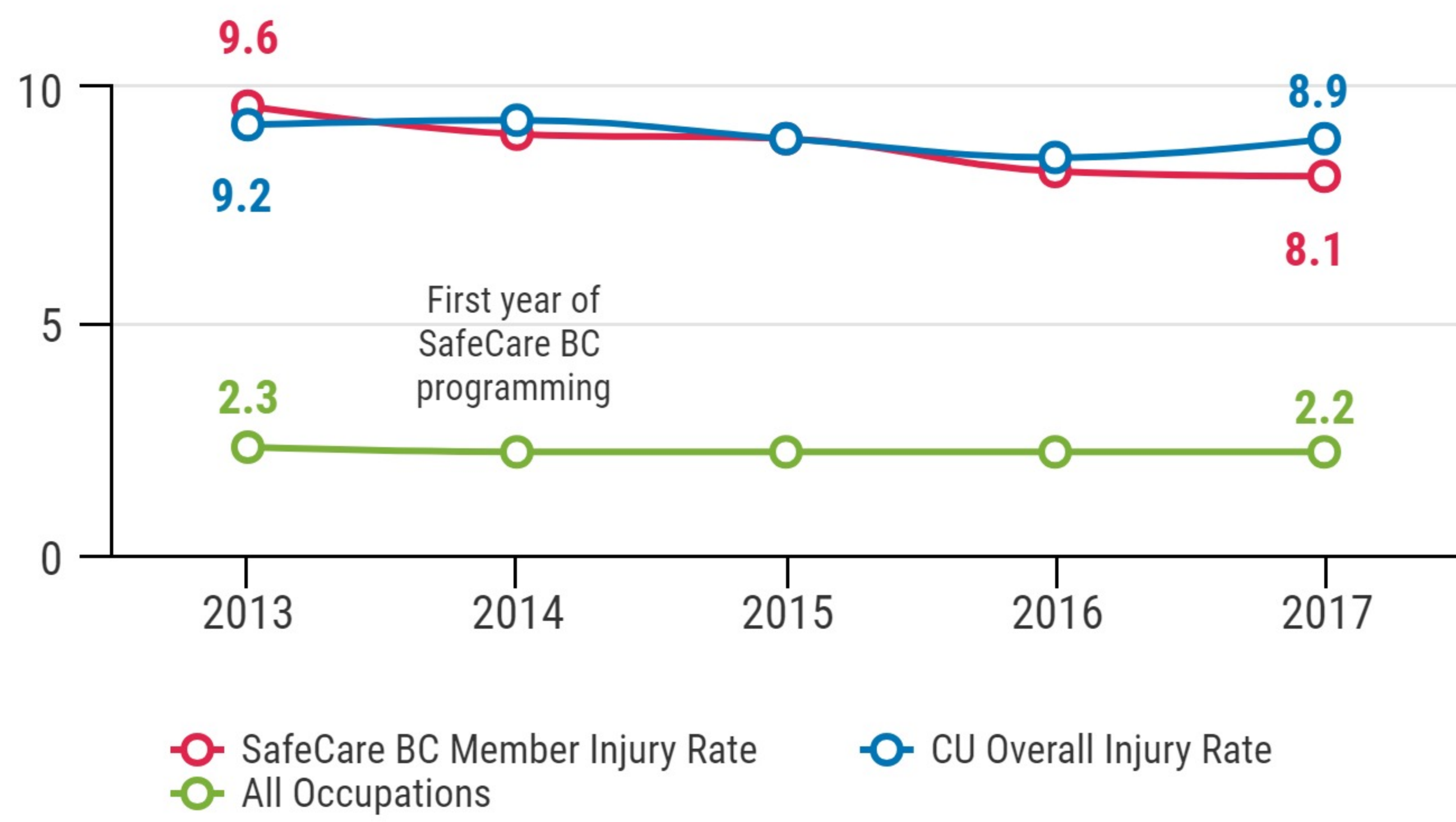

## LONG-TERM CARE

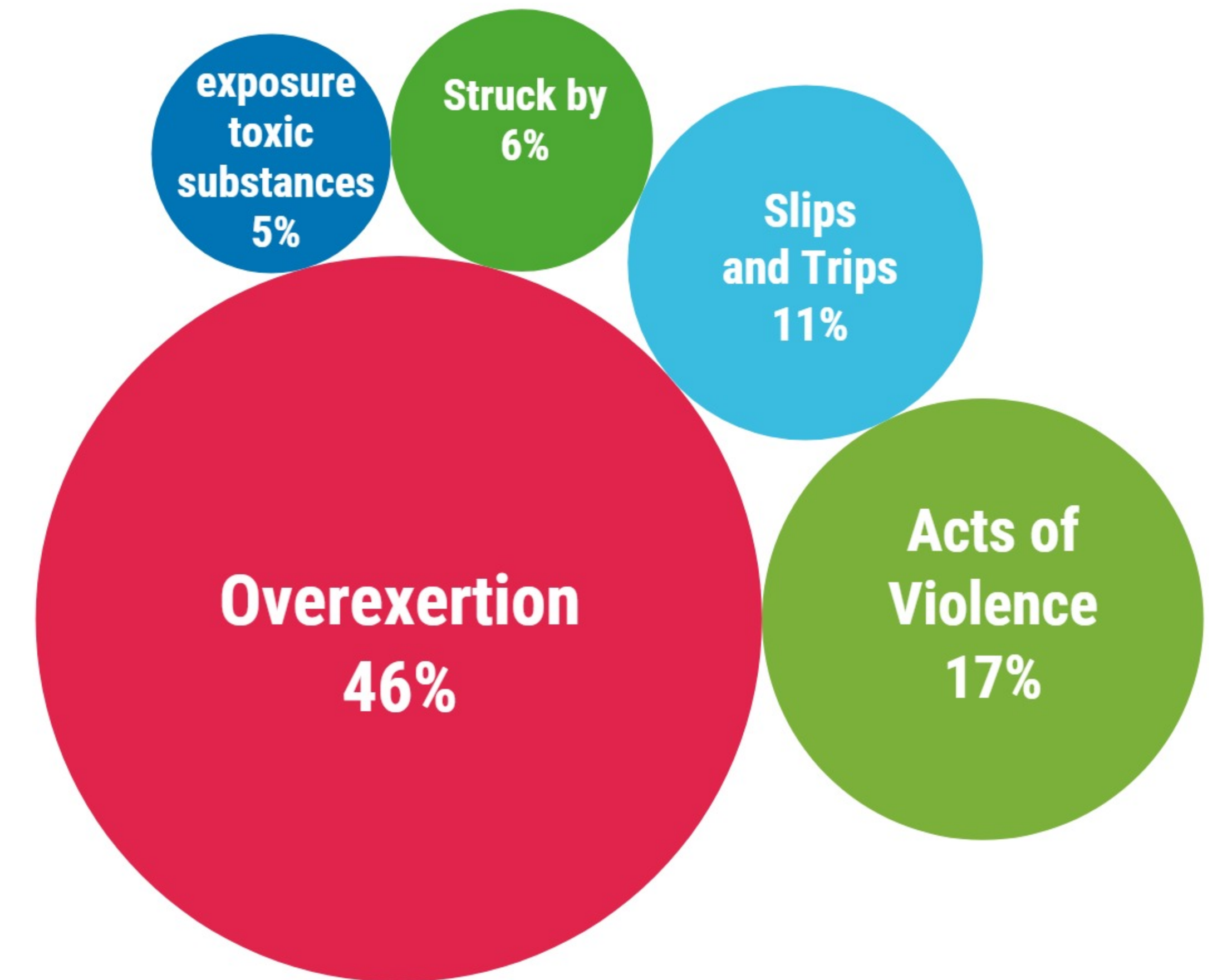
**INJURY RATE IS ALMOST FOUR TIMES the provincial average of all occupations**



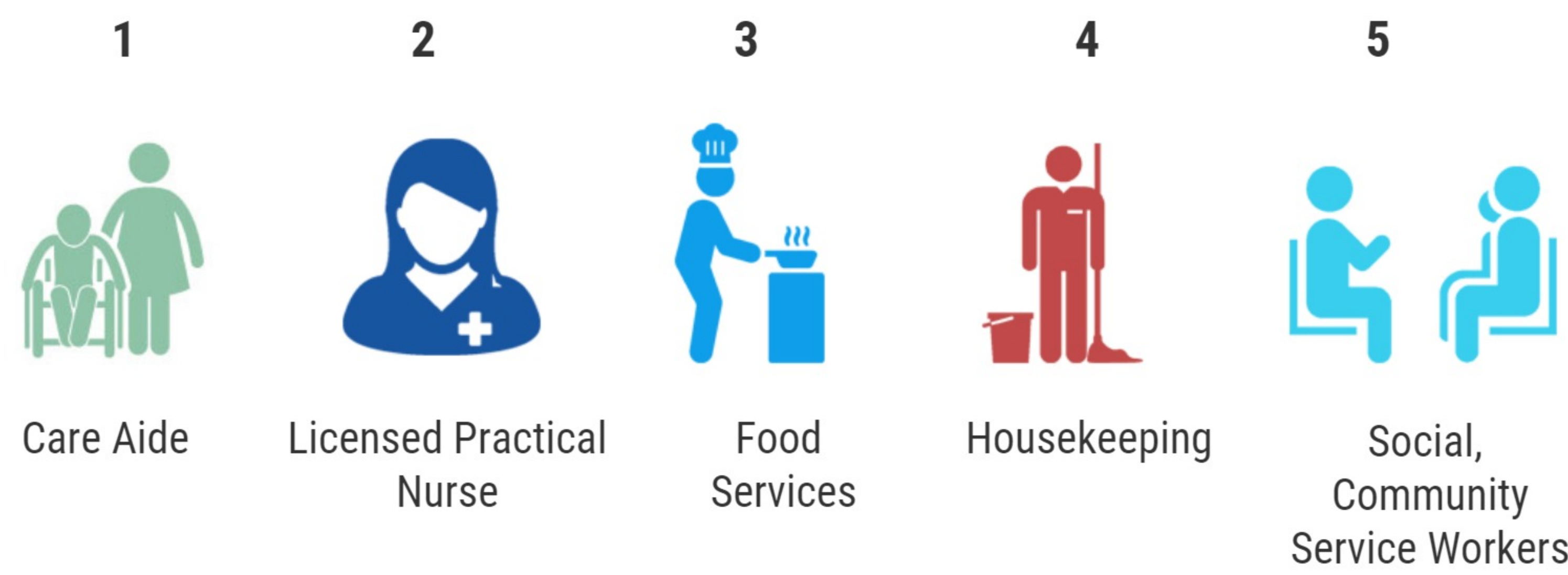

Injury rate decrease over past five years

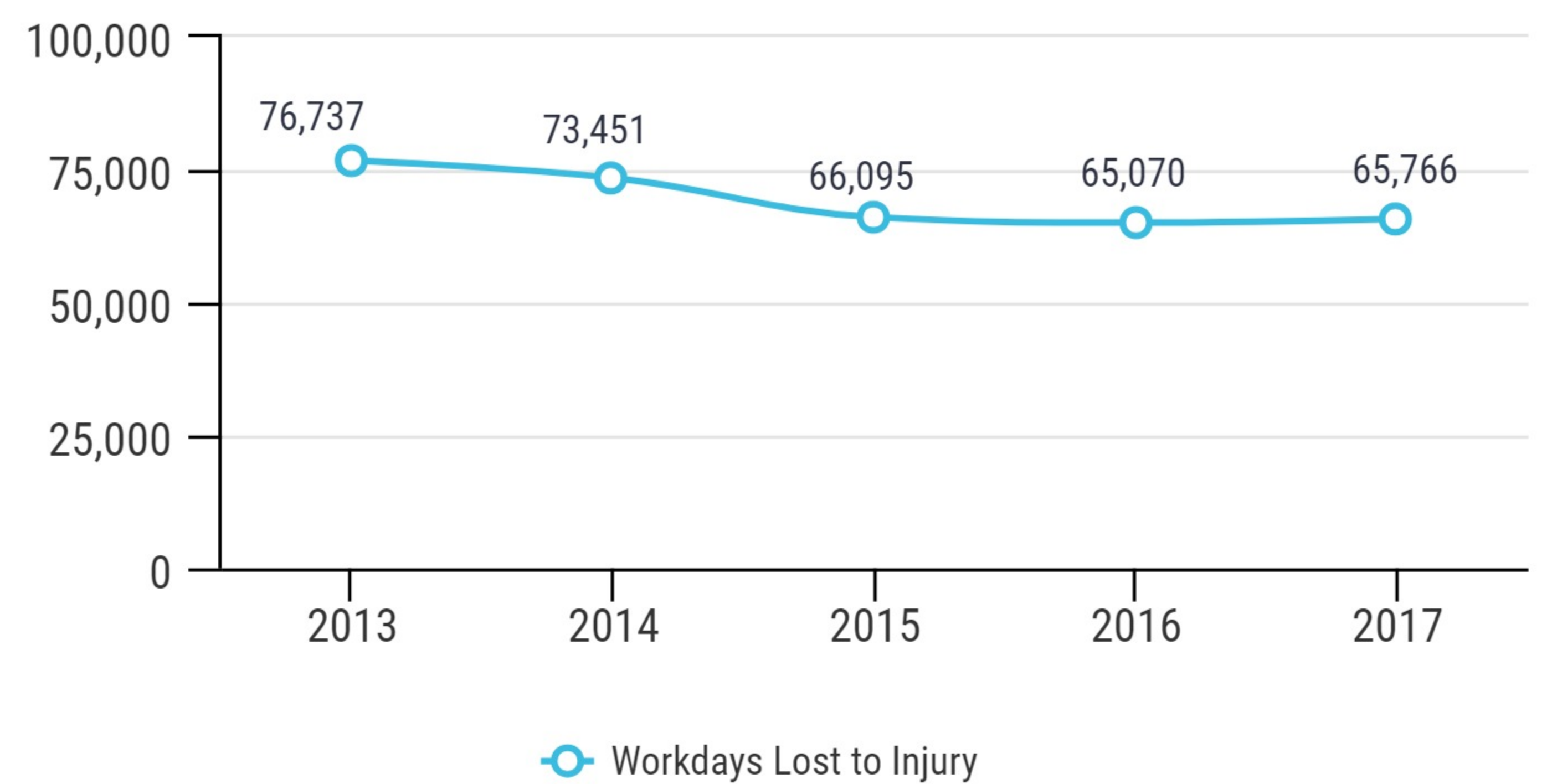
### Top 5 Accident Types
